Youth waterfowl weekend is upcoming Saturday, Sunday

Youth Waterfowl Weekend is set for Sept. 26 and 27. Licensed hunters, 15 years old and under, will be able to hunt ducks, mergansers, geese and coots statewide on these two days.

The two-day youth hunt is open to:

- legally licensed 12- to 15-year-olds who have completed hunter education and who are accompanied by a nonhunting adult at least 18 years of age; and
- properly certified and legally licensed apprentice hunters 10-15 years of age who are accompanied by a nonhunting adult "mentor" at least 21 years of age.

All regulations apply.

The Canyon Ferry Wildlife Management Area hours differ from the regulations for youth waterfowl weekend.

They will be one-half hour before sunrise to noon.

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**Lima Mother's Homicide Trial Moves
to Boulder, Set for January***Jeremy Crawford, Southwestern Montana News*

Nichole Boyer's trial on a deliberate homicide charge in the death of her 2-year-old son, Sammy Deut, is scheduled for January 2027 at the Jefferson County Courthouse.

The move from Beaverhead County follows an agreement between prosecutors and the defense.

Boyer contacted authorities in October 2025 to report her son's death. Investigators found the child's decomposing remains in an upstairs bedroom at the family's Lima home.

Court documents allege that Boyer stopped caring for the child and acknowledged that she should have done more. The allegations have not been proven at trial.

Boyer's father, Christopher Cox, also faces charges connected to Sammy's death. His proceedings have not changed venue, according to the Beaverhead County Attorney's Office.

The Dillon community and local first responders honored Sammy during a funeral and celebration of life in May 2026.

Boyer and Cox remain in the Beaverhead County Jail. Both are presumed innocent unless proven guilty.

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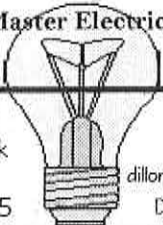

Mental Health Musings

Suicide is a leading cause of death in the United States, and, according to the Montana Department of Public Health and Human Services, is among the top 10 causes of death in our state--ranking eighth overall. When a person dies by suicide, the effects are felt by family, friends, and communities.

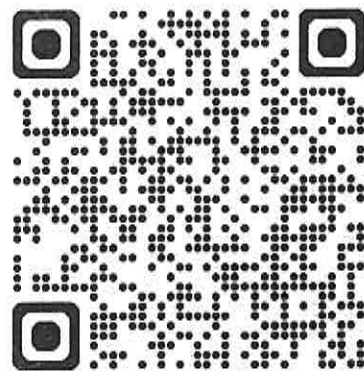
What are the warning signs of suicide?

Warning signs that someone may be at immediate risk for attempting suicide include:

- Talking about wanting to die or wanting to kill themselves
- Talking about feeling empty or hopeless or having no reason to live
- Talking about feeling trapped or feeling that there are no solutions
- Feeling unbearable emotional or physical pain
- Talking about being a burden to others
- Withdrawing from family and friends
- Giving away important possessions
- Saying goodbye to friends and family
- Putting affairs in order, such as making a will
- Taking great risks that could lead to death, such as driving extremely fast
- Talking or thinking about death often
- Other serious warning signs that someone may be at risk for attempting suicide include:

- Displaying extreme mood swings, suddenly changing from very sad to very calm or happy
- Making a plan or looking for ways to kill themselves, such as searching for lethal methods online, stockpiling pills, or buying a gun
- Talking about feeling great guilt or shame
- Using alcohol or drugs more often
- Acting anxious or agitated
- Changing eating or sleeping habits
- Showing rage or talking about seeking revenge

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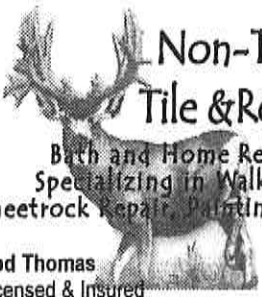

UMW Football's Comeback Falls Short vs. Rocky Mountain, 38-32

Montana Western football (1-2) fell to Rocky Mountain (1-2) 38-32 Saturday afternoon at Bulldog Stadium. The Bulldogs had a chance to win it late, but came up just short as time expired.

"Unfamiliar territory for us at this point, dropping two games in a row, not so much for me as I have been through this before, but for our coaches and these players" head coach Ryan Nourse said. "We are super inconsistent on defense and giving up multiple long runs each game. And up front on offense very inconsistent in short yardage blocking assignments which have taken multiple scores off the board for us so far this year. Things we can certainly fix. I was so excited to see all those young players on offense fight their tails off. Kaden LaPlaunt, Brody Munson, and Colton Cornwell showed fight and competitive character and we almost pulled out the victory at the end. I know where we need to go and I will make tough decisions to get us there and our guys will battle and make it happen."

Rocky Mountain jumped out to a quick 14-0 lead in the first quarter with two scores from Jae'Sean Pete and led 14-2 at the end of the period thanks to a

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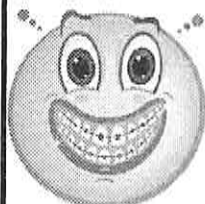
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safety courtesy of the Bulldog defense.

Seth Shook and Kaden LaPlaut connected on a one-yard pass to bring the score to 14-9 with 8:45 left in the second quarter, but the Battlin' Bears responded with another touchdown with five minutes remaining in the half to make it 21-9.

Maclain Burckley converted on a 15-yard field goal as time expired in the second to put things at 21-12 heading into the break.

Jordan Legg made a 29-yard field goal just after halftime to bring the score to 24-12 with just under nine minutes remaining in the third.

Rocky Mountain scored again at the tail end on an 85-yard run from Ty Battle to lead 31-12 with 10 minutes remaining in the contest.

Shook got things going in the final frame with a 13-yard TD from LaPlaut to make it 31-19.

Colton Cornwell caught a two-yard touchdown pass with less than five minutes remaining to close the gap to five, 31-26, but Rocky managed to march down the field and score again (Battle) to push the lead back to 12 (38-26).

Legg missed a 46-yard field goal attempt at the 1:36 mark, giving the Bulldogs the final drive of the contest.

The Bulldogs got the ball into Battlin' Bear territory, but couldn't find the endzone as time expired, resulting in the 38-32 win for the visitors.

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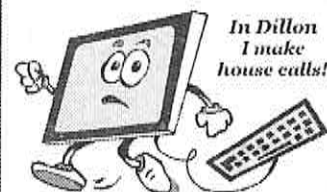
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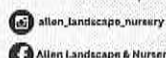


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Bulldog Volleyball Clipped by Dakota State, 3-0, Friday

The Montana Western volleyball team (4-9, 3-3 FC) fell to Dakota State (7-4, 4-1 FC) Friday evening.

NOTABLES : Jaiden Perez hit a season-best .455 clip.

Averi Look reached double digits in kills for the fifth time this season. Madisyn Frazier matched her career high with three aces.

The two sides swapped the lead back-and-forth through the opening frame. The hosts pulled away late to take the 1-0 lead with a 25-20 set win. The Bulldogs led for much of the second period, but the Trojans managed to steal the set in extra points, 26-24, for the 2-0 lead. Western jumped out to an early advantage in the final frame, but Dakota State clawed its way back into the lead late in the set. The hosts went on a 7-3 run to claim the set 25-19 and the match 3-0.

Montana Western Women's Cross-Country Takes Eighth, Men Place 10th at Montana Invite

The Montana Western women's cross-country team finished eighth while the men placed 10th at the Montana Invite Friday evening.

Natalee Stevens was the top Bulldog women's finisher for the second meet in a row, clocking a 20:17.4 in the 5k to place 39th out of 101 runners.

Ryker Zuffelato topped the UMW men's team with a 27:58.1 in the 8k to finish 62nd out of 115 runners. It marks the first top-finish of Zuffelato's collegiate career.

Justene Santi (20:42.7, 53rd), SheaLee Novak (21:33.5, 67th), Madison Lohmeyer (22:32.6, 73rd), Cadence Cameron (23:00.4, 76th), Kaelyn Sangray (23:26.1, 81st), Tiara Norris (23:26.3, 82nd), and Kylee Wyatt (30:38.1, 85th) rounded out the Bulldog women's team finishers.

Stevens and Santi went one and two for Western for the second straight meet, showcasing their consistency.

Cael Thilmony (28:10.6, 67th), Gavin Jasper (28:50.1, 75th), Tristan Von Bargaen (29:36.4, 80th), Brody Henry (29:36.4, 81st), Noah Rovente (29:58.5, 84th), Blake Olson (30:02.4, 85th), Greg Butler (30:58.7, 89th), and Taylor Graham (31:48.0, 93rd) completed the men's finishers.

The top three Bulldog men's runner were within one minute of each other, and the entire men's team was within a four-minute spread.

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**Garrison and McInenly Earn All-Around Titles
as UMW Women's Rodeo Wins Dawson CC
Rodeo, Men Place Second**

Montana Western women's rodeo took home the team title and the men's team placed second at the Dawson CC Rodeo this weekend. Luke Garrison (330 points) won the men's all-around while Tynell McInenly (360 points) won the women's all-around for the Bulldogs.

The women's team topped the field with 345 points while the men's team came in second with 910 points.

UMW won four events each in the long go, short go, and in the average.

"We're very pleased with the way the girls competed to move themselves to number one in the region," head coach JT Robbins said. "The men's team got back on track and put themselves in a really good position."

LONG GO RESULTS; Bareback Riding: Quentin Personeni (76) and Quaide Skjonsberg (76) tied for second in the opening round of bareback.

Breakaway Roping: The Bulldogs took five of the top six spots in the long go breakaway. Jaycie Richey won the round with a 2.6-second ride, followed by McInenly (3.0, T-2nd), Jacee Winward (3.0, T-2nd), Murphy Gaasch (3.4, T-5th), and Laura Haight (3.4, T-5th).

Saddle Bronc: Randon Boyce took third in the saddle bronc with a score of 73 while Cade Costello finished sixth with a 67.

Steer Wrestling: Luke Garrison went 11.8 in his first go at the steer wrestling for a third place showing. Tatum Hansen clocked an 18.8 to finish sixth.

Goat Tying: McInenly sat first in the goat tying after the first round with a 6.3-second effort. Kenzie Reber's 7.1 landed her tied for third.

Barrel Racing: Kassidy Bremner rode to a 17.10 and a first-place spot in the barrel racing after the long go.

Saddle Bronc: Costello earned a 78 to win the short go saddle bronc. Boyce finished close behind with a 71 while Denten



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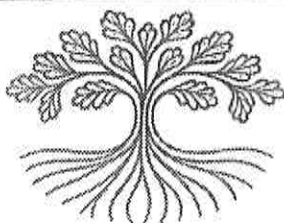
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Skjonsberg tallied a 63 for a fourth place showing.

Breakaway Roping: Gaasch's two-run score of 7.8 put her second overall in the breakaway, followed by Kesl in third (8.1), McInenly (15.5), and Richey (2.6, one clean run).

Saddle Bronc: Costello (145) won the saddle bronc average while Boyce (144) took second and Denten Skjonsberg (123) finished fourth.

Steer Wrestling: Garrison's two successful rounds (17.4 seconds on average) put him second in the overall standings while Hansen placed fourth at 40.2 seconds over two.

Goat Tying: McInenly took home the goat tying crown with a 13.6-second combined time. Kesl (15.4) and Reber (15.5) went fifth and sixth, respectively.

Barrel Racing: Bremner's 35.17-second two-run time earned her the average title in the barrel racing.

Team Roping: Garrison and Poppe topped all teams with a 16.5 second two-run time in the team roping. Begger and McInenly ended in third at 33.3 seconds and Bott and Severe finished fifth with a 7.2-second one-run time.

WHAT'S NEXT : The Bulldogs return to Dillon next week to host the Montana Western Rodeo Sept. 25-26. It marks the third of four rodeos Western will take part in during the fall slate.

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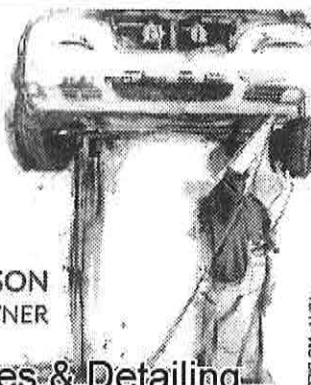

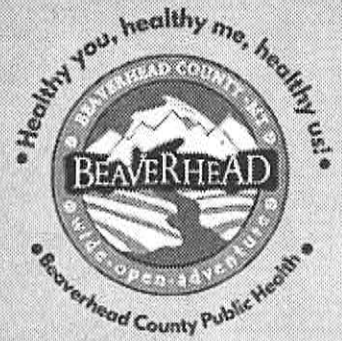
